# INFORMATION & REGISTRATION



## YOU WILL NEED TO BRING:

1. Original Birth Certificate showing parents' names (long format) and/or Canadian Citizenship Card. If non-Canadian, CSQ, Permanent Residency Card, IMM 1442, etc. will also be required. **AND;**
2. Valid Quebec Medicare card **AND;**
3. Most recent Statement of Marks from the Ministry of Education;
4. End-of-year report cards from every year attended in High School;
5. Registration payment (\$ 50) + book fees



## SESSIONS



There are four sessions:

1. **Summer School:** August 8—26
2. **Fall Session:** August 31 —December 23
3. **Winter Session:** January 9, 2017— April 13, 2017
4. **Spring Session:** April 18—June 27, 2017



## AGE REQUIREMENT

Adult Education students must be at least **16 years of age before July 1, 2016**. Students under 18 years of age require a parent's signature on our 16-17 Form.



## TRANSPORTATION

Adult students who live outside the area serviced by public transportation may be permitted to ride on ETSB buses, provided space is available. **It is important to make a request when you register. However, students may be obliged to find their own means of transportation while the request is being processed. Delays are to be expected in the first few weeks of school.**

## PLACEMENT TESTS



If you have not been attending High School for several years or if you were not successful in the last level you were studying, you may be required to take placement tests in English, French and/or Math.

Placement tests may take up to 3 hours to complete. These may be done at the Information Session.

## F E E S

**ALL Fees are due at Registration or at Course Selection** prior to the beginning of each session.



**\$ 25 - OPENING A FILE AND PLACEMENT TESTS:** this fee will be applied towards the Session Fees.

**\$ 50 - SESSION FEES:** this fee is for eligible\* students. Fees paid for Summer School also covers the Fall session.
