YOU WILL NEED TO BRING:

1. Birth Certificate showing parents' names (long format) and/or Canadian citizenship card. If non-Canadian: Permanent Residence Card, Imm 1442, CSQ, etc. will also be required;
2. Valid Québec Medicare card or Quebec Drivers license;
3. Most recent Statement of Marks from the Ministry of Education;
4. End-of-year report cards from every year attended in high school;
5. Registration fee (\$50) + book rental/purchase/consumable fee

AGE REQUIREMENT

Adult Education students must be at least 16 years of age before July 1, 2017. A parent's signature is required for students under 18 years of age.

PLACEMENT TESTS



If you have not been attending high school for several years or if you were not successful in the last level you were studying, you may be required to take placement tests in English, French and Math.

Placement tests may take up to 3 hours to complete.
